

## **Umrah Checklist**

## **Standard Requirements**

- A passport that's valid for at least 6 months from the date of travel with 3 or 4 blank pages for each traveler.
- 2 COLOUR passport size photographs (4cm x 6cm) taken against a plain white back ground for each traveler. If family members are on the same passport, pictures and names of all the family members must be added to the passport by the proper legal authority (Canadian citizens must all have separate passports INCLUDING CHILDREN)
- A stamped Immunization Card showing vaccination against Meningitis (one dose of ACYW135 vaccine) for adults. Meningitis (Menactra) and POLIO record for children under 15 years old. Two doses of (A) vaccine (1 to 2 months between each dose for children ages 3-24 months).

Cholera is highly recommended.

Make sure to take the health certificate to Saudi Arabia.

- Fully completed and signed Saudi visa application form (typed out or block letter written), original and copy
- Ladies and children need proper proof of relationship (marriage certificate for married couples)
- Children 18 and under must have a long birth certificates for children born in Canada indicating names of both parents OR any other legal document showing both parents names.
  - Long birth certificates can be obtained from your Provincial Service Ministry
- All documents must be photocopied only for Processing of Visa.

## **Special Requirements**

- Non-Canadian applicants must submit a clear photocopy for both side of the Permanent Residence card.
- Pilgrims who have non-Muslim names must have a statement from any Islamic Center showing their conversion to Islam.
- For married women traveling alone, the following is required:
  - She has to be over 45 years old:
    - A permission letter from husband (or Mehrem), signed and stamped by notary
    - A copy of ID showing signature of Mehrem (passport or driver's license).
